Molly Saleen Announces Her Official Entry in *The Great American Run*

Molly Saleen has announced her official entry in *The Great American Run*. She is scheduled to begin the Ultimate Rally July 29<sup>th</sup> in Miami, FL with her personally designed and built Saleen Mustang. Ms. Saleen's Mustang has had copious press coverage since its modest debut in early 2007, with momentum building as *The Great American Run* draws near.

The custom Saleen Mustang began with a stock S281-SC, and has undergone a series of modifications before being transformed into what is now commonly known as "*Molly-Pop™*." The nickname stems from the custom, pink candy paint that is sure to be noticed. However, don't let the female touch fool you, *Molly-Pop™* is packing quite a kick with its' 500bhp, 475 lbs-ft of torque, Saleen engineered Watts Link style suspension, and Saleen designed aerodynamics. Ms. Saleen describes her car as a sour candy, "it looks sweet and inviting on the outside, but once you get mixed up with it, you're sorry you ever did."

Ms. Saleen is nothing to be taken lightly either. She has been involved with the family business her whole life, and has some official racing time under her belt. She has attended a number of racing schools along the west coast; running everything from karting to high performance street machines. In fact, she is only one race away from being eligible to compete as a licensed SCCA driver. Word has it that she's been practicing, in her spare time, for *The Great American Run* by doing weekly runs to Las Vegas, NV from her home in Orange County, CA. This should prove as a useful strategy for her in that she will be able to endure the driving aspect of *The Ultimate Rally*, as well as the glamorous events that will take place at each stop along the route.

Ms. Saleen graduated from the University of Southern California as an honors student in 2005, after which she went to work for Saleen, Inc. She is currently general manager of The Saleen Store in Irvine, CA; which was rated as the #1 speed shop in America by Maxim Magazine in 2005. Also, look for her and the appearance of *Molly-Pop™* in the upcoming issues of Mustang 5.0 magazine and Muscle Mustangs & Fast Fords magazine as a feature article.

Her personal website is scheduled to launch prior to the start of the rally and will feature daily webcasts of the "unofficial daughter of racing" and her *Molly-Pop™* Saleen.
